Application for work on trees in a Conservation Area

Proposal: Scots Pine Tree – fell

At: Well Cottage, Ham, Marlborough

Assigned Officer: Sue Morgan

It was noted that the tree was not a Scots Pine and was an evergreen from the Spruce/Larch family, of pyramid shape and standing about 50 feet tall at the junction of two properties. The tree was healthy but the applicant, supported by neighbours, said that the tree took away considerable light from her and neighbouring properties and had a propensity to shed its lower branches creating a hazard. The Parish Council took the view that its removal would not adversely affect the village conservation area and recorded a 'No Objection' decision.
